ALREADY HAVE A WILL? MAKE A QCD!

If you are at least 70.5 years old and have a Traditional IRA, then you're eligible to make a tax-free donation directly from your IRA, also known as a Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD). The year you turn 70.5, Traditional IRA holders must withdraw a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). You can satisfy your RMD requirement with tax-free QCD to Routt County United Way.
